Group Swim Lessons

These lessons are to help each child develop water safety awareness, become more comfortable in the water, and begin developing fundamental water skills. We offer three different groups, Pre-Beginner/Beginner (American Red Cross Levels I & II), Advanced Beginner (American Red Cross Level III), and Stroke Technique (American Red Cross Levels IV-VI). All of our instructors are certified and trained as Water Safety Instructors through the American Red Cross and follow the appropriate guidelines for teaching levels I through VI. Each participant will receive a certificate of achievement as well as an American Red Cross card when they successfully pass out of a level.

Level Descriptions

Pre-Beginner/ Beginner: Levels I & II

Level I introduces a non-swimmer to the water and works on skills related to moving comfortably with support in the water. Level II is for non-swimmers who are adjusted to the water and are working towards swimming with no support.

Advanced Beginner/Stroke Readiness: Level III

This level is for swimmers who are ready to work on specific swimming strokes and skills.

Stroke Technique: Levels IV-VI

These levels are for swimmers who are developing and working on basic water safety skills, individual competitive strokes, leisure strokes, swimming endurance, and other water skills. This group is great for children who may want to join the swim team next summer or are currently on the team. It will help to refine their stroke mechanics and keep them in the water out of season.
